4. Choose Your Project Manager Select someone who not only has strong

5. Attend AI Technical Training

Make sure your IT team fully understands the AI tools and how to implement them. You can have them attend the <u>Designing</u> and <u>Implementing a Microsoft Azure AI</u> <u>Solutions</u> (AI-102) class, and then validate their skills by taking the exam to become Microsoft Certified: Azure AI Engineers.







6. Implement Your 1st Al Project With Leadership's support, a Project Manager, and IT SMEs on-board, develop a robust project plan. Don't forget drafting company Al policies to mitigate risks and guide acceptable use.



7. Train Your Employees

Ensure all employees using Al attend user training sessions to learn how to work with their new Al tools and to reinforce company policies. The class <u>Empower</u> <u>Your Workforce with Microsoft Copilot</u> <u>365</u> is a great option for this purpose.



8. Project Review
